## **Richmond's Approach to Incentivizing Housing Production**

**Description:** Richmond offers two great examples of how public private partnerships can provide innovative and effective solutions to increase affordable housing production: the City of Richmond's <u>Affordable Housing Performance Grant Program</u>, created to incentivize the development of affordable multifamily housing; and Henrico County's <u>Affordable Housing Trust Fund</u>, designed to support affordable homeownership. Both efforts were spurred by housing leaders – both for-profit and nonprofit – offering new approaches to deploy public funding to bolster financing opportunities and support ongoing operations. We will be joined by two dynamic housing leaders to describe these efforts – Bernard Harkless of Lynx Ventures and Jovan Burton of the Richmond Partnership for Housing Affordability – which will be followed by an interactive discussion of local initiatives across the country.
